Luke 6:46-49

Questions:

1. Describe a time your life collapsed because you hadn't put Jesus' words into practice.
2. Describe a time when your life stood firm despite storms because you had put Jesus' words into practice.
3. What areas of your life are you currently building on the rock (Jesus)? What areas are you building on the sand?

- Discuss whether or not you are building your family on the rock. If not, discuss what are you building it on and how you can make a change.
- Draw a picture of the wise and foolish builders parable.
- Pray.

Questions:

1. List some people that fall into each category of this parable. Where do you fall?

3. What produces good soil? How can you cultivate the soil of your life? How can you cultivate the soil of someone else?

- Discuss the soil of your family. How receptive are you to Jesus and His teaching?
- Purchase some seeds and find some good soil to put them in.
- Pray.

Questions:

1. Compare and contrast how you view God with how He is illustrated in this story.
2. Describe a time when you were like the lost son.

- Read passage.
- Discuss God's grace as illustrated in this story and how your family can better demonstrate it to others.
- Have a party, even if just a small one, to celebrate God's grace. Put party hats on when you eat, buy ice cream, or use special silverware.
- Pray.
