

Questions:

1. In the first week of this series we read that the dark has not overcome the light. In this passage, the dragon tries to devour the child - the Light of the World. What are some ways that you see people trying to destroy the truths of Jesus in our world today?
2. How has the world try to destroy the light in you?
3. What can you do to make sure that the light shines brightly from you (in your family work place, etc.)?

- Read passage
- Discuss your family can be a brighter light to the world (see Matthew 5:14-16).
- Sing "This Little Light of Mine" together (make sure to include the "Don't let satan blow it out" part.
- Pray that God will help your light shine.

Weekly Challenge


Do something for someone that is reflects the light you have in you...Think random act of kindness. Consider including your family or friends in this.

3. How has Jesus illuminated your life? Give specific examples.

Questions:

1. This passage states that the Word (Jesus) is God. What light does this shed on how you ought to celebrate Christmas?
2. List a few areas in our society that seem to be getting more dark.
3. Darkness does not overcome the light. In what areas of your life do you need the reminder that Jesus' is greater than that which is bad/evil?

Family

- Do the Bible App for Kids Adventure Book, if applicable.
- Read passage
- Discuss the benefits of light (physically) and how they can apply to Jesus.
- After the sun goes down, turn off all the lights in your house. Discuss how difficult would be without a light. Turn on a flashlight or candle and...
- Pray. Thank Jesus for coming to earth and all the benefits it brings us.
